<p><b>Lasioglossum species</b> (Parasphecodes subgenus)</p> <p>Small/medium</p> <p>Usually dark red abdomen</p> <p><b>Red bee</b></p>		<p><b>Hylaeus &amp; Meroglossa species</b></p> <p>Small/medium</p> <p>Black with yellow/pale markings on face and/or thorax</p> <p><b>Masked bees</b></p>	
<p><b>Lipotriches species</b></p> <p>Medium</p> <p>Metallic abdomen with white/orange hair bands</p> <p><b>No common name</b></p>		<p><b>Megachile species</b></p> <p>Medium/large</p> <p>Abdomen stripes; orange tail</p> <p>Pollen under abdomen</p> <p><b>Leafcutter and Resin bees</b></p>

<p><b>Euryglossa species</b></p> <p>Medium</p> <p>Body black, sometimes iridescent</p> <p><b>No common name</b></p>		<p><b>Thyreus species</b></p> <p>Medium</p> <p>Black with blue dotted pattern on abdomen</p> <p><b>Cuckoo bees</b></p>	
<p><b>Xylocopa species</b></p> <p>Large</p> <p>Metallic green thorax and abdomen</p> <p><b>Carpenter bees</b></p>		<p><b>Euryglossina species</b></p> <p>Very small</p> <p>Yellow/black body colouring</p> <p><b>Euryglossine bees</b></p>
